

Subtheme Start Time: Choose a Curriculum Area: Materials: start time. Choose a curriculum split splat adapted book End Time: Choose an area. spray bottle w/ water and end time. Choose a curriculum essential oil area. sensory rain bottle Objective(s): Students will point to and describe pictures and illustrations within an adapted book. \*Save book to read on a day in the spring when it rains. Introduction: Have students look outside and identify what type of weather it is. It's raining! Today we are going to read a story about the rain. Body: Read adapted story to students. Pause so they can interact with the different textures on each page. Talk about and point to different things the little girl does. Wait for students to make comments about the pictures using their voices. Use spray bottle to lightly mist students when the little girl splashes in the puddles. Closing: "This afternoon we are going to take a walk in the rain just like this little girl." Review what students will need before they go in the rain (e.g. umbrella, coat, rainboots, etc.).
