Objective(s):

Introduction:

- Students will review the adapted story about community members
- Review that these people help the community

Body:

- Using a touch TV or the Tap-It, studenst will match the community member to the environment they work in.
 - After a correct choice is made, teacher expands on the place. "Good job. A firefighter works at a fire house. A teacher works in a school."
 - o Teacher asks comprehension questions. *IEP GOALS
- Talk about what each of the different members wear(e.g. mailman carries bag of mail, police officers wear a badge, metro workers wear a bright yellow vest, etc.)
 - o Let students try on different dramatic play props as they talk about each community helper

Closing:

- Teacher will review the different community members and where they work
- Talk about strangers how these adults are safe strangers
