### Objective(s):

Students will be able to use a phone or other resources to obtain emergency help.

### Introduction:

- Teacher will read the social story titled "In an Emergency.." aloud to students.

### Body:

- Teacher will review the three things you must be able to tell a 911 operator
  1. Who you are
  2. What your problem is
  3. Where you are
- Teacher will divide students up into partners and give each pair a mock emergency scenario
- Students will practice saying the three things outloud to their partner or by using their VOD
- Set timer for \_\_\_\_\_ minutes
- Each partner will have a chance to be the person calling 911 and the operator
- If group finishes early, have students practice dialing their phone number and reciting their address

### Closing:

- \* Ask if any pairs want to perform for whole group
- \* Teacher will review the reasons why we would have to call 911 (you or someone else is in danger)
- \* Review three things you must be able to tell operator
- \* **Extension activity** → sort different scenarios into emergency or NOT
