### Objective(s):

• Students will identify vocabulary that corresponds to the laundry sequence.

• Students will use objects, picture symbols, photographs and printed words to identify vocabulary related to laundry.

#### Introduction:

Teacher will briefly review the adapted text about laundry with students.

 Teacher will review the lesson vocabulary when reading story (washer, dryer, laundromat, clean, sort, load, detergent, basket, fold and dirty).

### **Body:**

• Teacher will divide students into five groups of two. Students will rotate through the different groups where they practice using the vocabulary word in context. Students will spend 2-4 minutes at each group depending on time.

- 1. H4 changing room
  - label washer & dryer
  - practice loading clothes into washer and then moving to dryer
- 2. sort clothes into three groups: darks, whites, colors
- 3. sort pictures of clothes into two groups: clean or dirty
- 4. practice folding a shirt using a folding board and putting in a laundry basket
- 5. practice pouring detergent into cap and then pouring into another container
  - use adapted pourer

#### Closing:

- Review the different stations they visited and will comment on what they did at each station.
- Check for understanding by holding up different laundry vocab words and have students label/identify them.
- Tell students they are preparing for a CBI to a nearby laundromat next week and will be practice completing different steps of the laundry sequence before the CBI.






Some people have washers and dryers at home to keep their clothes <u>clean</u>.










Other people go to a laundromat to wash and dry their clothes.








First, <u>sort</u> your laundry into three piles; darks, colors, and whites.








Only wash one group at a time or you could make them <u>dirty</u> and ruin your clothes.










Load clothes into the washing machine.









Put in <u>detergent</u>.








When they are finished, move them to the <u>dryer</u>.




