### Objective(s):

Students will expand and generalize ability to make purchases across community settings.

Students will expand and generalize subtraction skills to school-based job training settings.

### Introduction:

**\*have classroom ready with three "food trucks" when students are out of the classroom so that they are all set up when students enter the classroom. Have students or staff man each food truck and wear hairnet and gloves. Also have a cash register available so that "food truck employees" can make change for students.**

- Teacher will review previously read adapted Food Truck book and connect it back to the theme \_\_\_\_\_.
- "Today we are going to practice purchasing something from a food truck."
- "As you can see, we have three different food trucks set up in the classroom that you can choose to purchase from today. You can choose to buy a grilled cheese, a pizza or barbecue."
- "We are not going to get the actual item you purchase today but we are practicing for tomorrow when we actually go find and purchase something from a food truck!"
- "Each of you has your own envelope with money if it for you to buy your food truck item/complete your purchase."

### Body:

- "Can anyone help me review the steps of ordering fast food?"
  - look at menu
  - decide what you want
  - wait in line
  - order food
  - pay for food
  - wait for change if you're getting any
  - wait for food to be handed to you
  - say thank you
- Have students proceed through mock purchase with as much independence as possible.
- Once students complete the purchase, have the food truck employee had them an empty pizza box, or bag so that the student can practice, waiting, taking the food and saying thank you.

**Closing:**

- "You guys did an awesome job today! You are going to do fantastic at the food truck tomorrow."
- "Remember the steps to making a fast food purchase are...."
- "This afternoon, we are going to vote on the type of food truck we want to. Then tomorrow we will use the Food Truck Tracker <http://foodtruckfiesta.com/> to figure out where it will be located. We will need to use a map and figure out metro times to know how to get there on time."
