## Subtheme

**Curriculum Area:**  
Functional Social Studies

### Materials:

- sports equipment from PE
  - hockey stick
  - soccer ball
  - basketball
  - baseball glove
  - football
- adapted book
- differentiated worksheet

### Objective(s):

Students will identify the local professional sports teams that represent the nation's capital.

### Introduction:

- Teacher will ask students what they did this weekend.
- If no other students comment on watching a game, teacher will say that she watched the Redskins game on Sunday night.
- Teacher will connect sports to the theme "Things to do" in my city.
- "We are going to read a story about different sports teams in our city."

### Body:

- Teacher will read adapted story aloud w/ students
  - have sports equipment available for students to hold/manipulate while reading or listening to the story.
  - \*ask to borrow from PE
- After reading the story, teacher can choose to show brief clips of the sports team playing
- Teacher will have students complete the logo match worksheet.
  - students should be encouraged to look back at the text if they are unsure

### Closing:

- Teacher will have students share the answers to the logo match.
- Organize a way for students to wear their favorite sports teams apparel later in the week. Send home flyer for parents.
- "Tomorrow we will look at a map to determine where these different sport venues are located. We will see how we could navigate there from St. Coletta or out in the community."

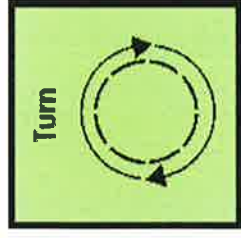


**Washington, DC is the nation's capital.**





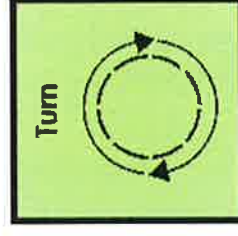
**There are many sports teams
